The Summerland Skating Club is an important community club that runs after school programs six days a week from September to March. We have two Club Coaches successfully running the Canskate Tots, Canskate, Starskate Intermediate and Starskate Senior programs together at this time. There will be an opening next season for someone to coach in all of these areas.

Canskate is our biggest group of skaters with the club. We also invite Minor Hockey's youngest players to learn to skate with the Canskate group. The new coach will be required to display enthusiasm, a positive attitude and strong teaching skills that this group will demand. The Canskate Tots run from 3:00 – 3:30 and Canskate runs from 3:30 – 4:15 on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Working with Program Assistants (Senior skaters), planning for special event days, the Christmas party and our end of the year Pop Concert will be a necessity for the new coach to help out with. The ability to communicate with parent volunteers will be essential as well.

There will be opportunities for the new coach to give private lessons to skaters in the Starskate program. The Summerland Skating Club has skaters ranging from the Preliminary level up to Gold that take tests and compete.
