GENERAL INFORMATION

Singles, pairs and dance events are open to registered skaters in good standing with Skate Canada and the United States Figure Skating Association or any ISU affiliated club. The competition is sanctioned by Skate Canada. It is organized and shall be conducted in accordance with the current Skate Canada Rulebook, except where modified in this announcement.

1. Previous winners of a Pre-Preliminary event must move up. There are no restrictions for other categories that a skater may have won previously.
2. STARSkate Categories: Should entries in any STARSkate event be exceedingly large, the event will be divided into smaller groups which will be divided by age. Each group will be considered a final.
3. Competitive Categories: Should entries be exceedingly large, the event will be divided into smaller groups by random draw. Each group will be considered a final. Short and Free Programs will be entered and judged as separate events.
4. Skaters may enter only one event per discipline of singles, pairs and dance. This includes a short and a free program in competitive singles and pair categories; a compulsory, original and free dance in competitive dance categories.
5. MARKING
The CPC Scoring system will be used for all Competitive events and STARSkate Free Skate events from Junior Bronze to Gold. STARSkate Pre-Preliminary and Preliminary Free Skate will be judged using 6.0. Elementary level Free Skate events will be offered as Performance Program. Information on the Performance Program can be found on the Technical Page of the Skating in BC website. www.skatinginbc.com
6. Competitors may "skate-up" one category above their qualifications in this competition.
7. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN AFTER THE CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES (11:59 p.m. July 14, 2010) FOR ANY REASON WHATSOEVER. LATE ENTRIES WILL BE CHARGED DOUBLE THE ENTRY FEE. FOR THOSE PAYING BY CASH, CHEQUE OR MONEY ORDER, PAYMENT FOR ENTRY MUST BE RECEIVED IN THE SECTION OFFICE BY JULY 21ST, 2010 OR THE ENTRY WILL BE CANCELLED.**
8. Should entries have to be limited due to time constraints, they will be limited in the lower end STARSkate categories. There will be no limiting of entries in Competitive categories.
9. PRACTICE ICE: Practice Ice will be available for all skaters at \$15.00 for 30 minutes. A practice schedule will be posted on the Section website (www.skatinginbc.com). Practices can be booked by calling the BC/YT Section office during office hours 8:30 am – 4:30 pm Monday to Friday (604) 205-6960 or toll free 1-888-752-8322; or forms can be down loaded off the website and faxed or mailed to the Section office with payment. Payment is required at the time of booking.
PLEASE NOTE: No music will be played on practice ice sessions.
10. ATTENTION ALL COACHES: It is mandatory for all participating coaches to register at competitions and show their accreditation at all times during the competition in order to be at ice level during the events. Temporary accreditation will be issued for \$25.00 by showing current Skate Canada membership and First Aid information.
11. SKATERS TAKING TESTS – A Test Application form should be completed and submitted according

to information on the form posted on the Section website. Deadline for test applications is July 30, 2010.

12. TENTATIVE SCHEDULE OF EVENTS & GROUPS will be posted on the BC/YT Section website (www.skatinginbc.com). Individual skaters will NOT receive a mailing with schedule and group information. There will be an official bulletin board at the arena listing the starting time of all events. This schedule will supersede all other schedules. The posting of notices on this official bulletin board will be considered sufficient notification to competitors. Please note that events may start up to one half hour earlier than scheduled.

13. STARTING ORDERS will be posted on the BC/YT Section website 24 hours prior to the start of the competition.

14. FEES:

STARSkate Categories Performance Program and Pre-Preliminary Singles \$55.00
Preliminary to Gold Singles \$65.00

Competitive Categories - Pre-Juvenile & Juvenile singles \$65.00
Pre-Novice to Senior Singles \$65.00 per part
Pairs & Dance (each part) \$65.00 per couple

NOTE: Your entry fee must accompany the entry form. Please make all cheques or money orders payable to: "SKATE CANADA - BC/YT SUMMMERSKATE". No post-dated cheques past July 14th, 2010 will be accepted.

15. ENTRIES must be in the hands of the registrar (BC/YT Section Office) by midnight July 14th, 2010. Eligibility for entries is governed by tests passed and/or age restriction as of July 1st, 2010. If only one entry is received for an event, the entry fee will be refunded and the event cancelled.

16. PLANNED PROGRAM SHEETS may be submitted online with skater entry information or sent to the BC/YT Section office via fax or mail.

17. MUSIC: Only CD's will be accepted and only one program shall be recorded on each CD. CDs must be marked with the competitor's name, home club, event, and total music time (not skating time) and enclosed in their integral container, also marked accordingly. Competitors must hand in their music at the registration desk at least one hour prior to the start of their event. The SummerSkate Committee will accept no responsibility against damage, but will take every precaution to safeguard each CD. A backup CD is a requirement of each competitor and should be at rinkside during the skater's performance.

18. ADMISSION will be free to all. There will be no reserved seating.

19. AWARDS will be presented immediately following the posting of results for each category.

- COMPETITIVE CATEGORIES: Compulsory Dances, Short/OD, Free Programs and Elements will be entered and judged as separate categories. The top three placements in each category will receive medals. Categories with a large number of entries may be divided into groups, with medals being given to the top three placements in each group. For competitors entering all parts of a category, a combined final score for the top twenty placements will be produced and posted on the results board only.
- STARSKATE CATEGORIES: Medals will be awarded for the top three placements in each group. Skaters placing 4 and up in Pre-Preliminary and Preliminary Free Skate categories will receive ribbons. Performance Program participants will receive written feedback and a Bronze, Silver or Gold Award of Merit.

20. REGISTRATION

Skaters must register at least one (1) hour before their event is scheduled to start.

21. WARM-UP TIMES

Performance Program & Pre-Preliminary	3 minutes
Preliminary, Junior & Senior Bronze	4 minutes
Junior Silver to Gold Free Skate	5 minutes
Pre-Juvenile	5 minutes
Juvenile to Senior Competitive	6 minutes

Dance warm-up times will be according to SC Regulations.

* At the discretion of the Referee, the warm up periods may be reduced to a minimum of 3 minutes.

All warm-up periods for one event must be equal.

22. ARENA

The competition will be held at Burnaby Ice Sport Centre, 6501 Sprott St., Burnaby, BC. The ice surface is 85' x 200' with slightly rounded corners.
