RULES AND PROCEDURES:

OPEN SESSIONS – Open Sessions are for all levels. Therefore, the following rules should be need to be enforced.

- ❖ No one, skater nor coach should dominate the music.
- ❖ Elite skaters should not jump if they are more than 15 skaters on the session.
- ❖ No Team Skating (unless less than 6)
- ❖ Sr.A, Elite skaters cannot demand less ability skaters to move.
- ❖ Coaches of Int., Sr.B skaters should encourage, and monitor the teaching of looking out and common sense ice manners.
- ❖ Junior skaters must be with their coach.
- ❖ Volume of sound system should not be at max.
- ❖ Skaters and coaches should use common sense to make sessions run smooth. If session counts more than 15, skaters should not use the Open Session as a training session but rather an extra session to work on a specific area of their training. Regular training should be done on accredited sessions were it is safe and abilities are equal.
- ❖ No swearing, temper tantrums, or improper behavior during Opens. Disrespect to full time coaches, administrators or directors will be considered member in poor standing and will be brought forward to Canlan management. Canlan has the right to terminate membership.
- ❖ Skaters that are constantly with a coach for the whole session everyday do not constitute right of way.
- ❖ Parents are not allowed to coach at the rink boards

COMMON SENSE:

- ❖ Soloist has #1 right of way – 2 times max per week
- ❖ Lesson skater has #2 right of way
- ❖ On coming skater watches spin skater
- ❖ Skater going backwards without looking is being foolish, and practicing poor safety on any crowded session.
- ❖ The week a skater competes should merit solo priority if other members have no immediate performance.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- ❖ There are **NO BCCOE Intermediate or Sr. B Off-Ice classes, Group Enrichment classes for any level, Jr. Academy or Learn to Skate** sessions. during May/June Off-Season Schedule.
- ❖ Skaters may only skate the accredited sessions that they qualify for.
- ❖ All skaters must fill out Off-Season Registration Form prior to skating.
- ❖ No skaters shall skate without registration and payment prior to session.
- ❖ The Registration Form is the only way the office can regulate how many skaters per session, which is for your safety, therefore ALL skaters must submit a completed registration form.
- ❖ Skaters **MUST** sign waiver form on the registration paper prior to skate.
- ❖ Sessions will be closed for Buy-on skaters if session membership is full.
- ❖ If Sessions are full, priority will be given to the year round skater of the BCCOE.
- ❖ **Memberships DO NOT include Open Sessions except Elite, Sr.A, and Full Dance Team. Skaters may buy on for the Open or pay for Open Membership, which allows skating on any Opens, any day, unlimited.**
- ❖ **Open session skaters MUST obey Open Session Procedure & Policy**
- ❖ **Skaters that are not accredited Intermediate or above must have their coach with them to be allowed to skate on Open Sessions. (This includes Junior Academy Privates)**
- ❖ **Canlan has the right to cancel sessions on short notice due to facility booking, mechanical problems, etc.**
