Canadian Development Level 1	<p>General Criteria: All athletes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- must be in good standing with BC/YT Section-Skate Canada and Skate Canada- must be registered with a club- on stream to make Senior National team in one year as verified by Skate Canada <p>Specific Criteria:</p> <p>Athletes who competed at the last Canadian Championships</p>
Canadian Development Level 1A	<p>General Criteria: All athletes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- must be in good standing with BC/YT Section-Skate Canada and Skate Canada- must be registered with a club- on stream to make Senior National team in 2-3 years as verified by Skate Canada <p>Specific Criteria:</p> <p>Athletes who competed at the last Canadian Championships and who do not qualify as Level 1</p>
Provincial Development Level 2	<p>General Criteria: All athletes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- must be in good standing with BC/YT Section-Skate Canada and Skate Canada- must be registered with a club- must be tracking towards Level 1/1a according to figure skating's athlete development pathway (LTAD)- has been on the high performance athlete pathway for a minimum of 2 years <p>Specific Criteria:</p> <p>Athletes who competed at the last Canadian Championships and who did not qualify as Level 1 or 1A OR Athletes who competed at the last Canadian Junior Championships</p>
Provincial Development Level 3	<p>General Criteria: All athletes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- must be in good standing with BC/YT Section-Skate Canada and Skate Canada- must be registered with a club- must be tracking towards Level 2 according to figure skating's athlete development pathway (LTAD)- has been on the high performance athlete pathway for a minimum of 2 years <p>Specific Criteria:</p> <p>Athletes who have qualified as a BC Team member at the last Western Challenge</p>
