Multi-Sport Training: The following nine modules must be completed as part of your National Coach certification.

1. Comp-Dev MED (if not already completed at the primary STAR level)
2. Design a Basic Sport Program (if not already completed at the ISPC level)
3. Coaching and Leading Effectively
4. Managing Conflict
5. Leading Drug Free Sport
6. Developing Athletic Abilities
7. Prevention & Recovery
8. Performance Planning/Program Management
9. Psychology of Performance

In-training status is issued once the biomechanics online module is completed successfully.

NATIONAL COACH IN-TRAINING



Sport-Specific Training:

- Analyze technical and tactical performance (2 days)

Trained status is achieved once all of the multi-sport and sport-specific training requirements are completed successfully.

To attend Canadians, a coach needs to have completed the following requirements:

Year 1:

- Biomechanics online module
- 5 of 9 multi-sport modules
- Analyze technical and tactical performance course

Year 2:

- The remaining multi-sport modules must be completed prior to attending Canadians in year 2.

NATIONAL COACH TRAINED



National Coach Certification:

Part 1: Evaluation portfolio – combination of requirements covering planning, coaching philosophy, safety and communication.

Part 2: In-training observation/evaluation (pre-brief, training session observation, and debrief)

Outcome: support athletes in training

Part 3: In-competition observation/evaluation (pre-brief, competition observation, and debrief)

Outcome: support the competitive experience

Part 4: Online evaluation –MED, managing conflict, leading drug free sport

A National Coach **certified** status should be completed if a coach plans to attend Canadians in year 3.
