



NCCP INSTRUCTION INTERMEDIATE PRIMARY STARSKATE COACH PATHWAY

Pre-Requisites:

CanSkate Coach trained (within 2 years) or certified
Completed either:

- One complete Senior Bronze STARSkate test

OR

- Junior Bronze Free Skate test and one other complete Junior Bronze STARSkate test

Coach Registration Requirements:

Eight CEP points on a two-year cycle, Valid First Aid, Back Check, Making Ethical Decisions on-line Evaluation (coach.ca)

Professional Development Opportunities (Sport Specific):

National Coaches Conference, Continuous Education Program, National Performance Centre Seminars, Section/Club Seminars

Primary STARSkate Home Study Guide

- Complete the Primary STARSkate Home Study Guide and have it marked successfully PRIOR to attending the Primary STARSkate course.



3-Day Primary STARSkate Course

Complete the 3-day Primary STARSkate course which also includes:

- Teaching one 15-minute lesson in front of a mentor coach
- In class assignments

PRIMARY STARSKATE COACH TRAINED

Primary STARSkate Evaluation Portfolio

Complete the Primary STARSkate evaluation portfolio which includes:

- 50 hours of practice coaching at the STARSkate level (min. 40 hours on-ice)
- Video Evaluation: Three different 15-minute lessons at the Primary STARSkate level (Preliminary or Junior Bronze; STAR 1-5)
- Further information regarding lesson requirements available in the portfolio.

- Coaches are recommended to achieve a Primary STARSkate Coach Certified status within two years of achieving a Primary STARSkate Coach Trained status.
