Entry fees shall be refunded only if the competition/event is not held or if the entry is withdrawn before the closing date of entry. NO refunds will be given after the closing date of entries of the competition (October 14, 2022) for any reason whatsoever.

For all categories, age shall be the age of the skater before July 1, 2022, and tests passed shall be as of October 14, 2022 (closing date of entries). **Age categories may be combined if there are insufficient entries in an individual category.**

**PLANNED PROGRAM SHEETS FOR ALL SINGLES EVENTS EXCEPT STAR 1,2,3 & 4 MUST BE SUBMITTED ONLINE. Deadline to submit changes to planned program sheets Friday, October 14, 2022 (closing date of entries). [Click here](#) to submit your planned program information. Program updates after Friday, October 14, 2022, need to be submitted no later than November 15, 2022, by emailing to [viregionskating@gmail.com](mailto:viregionskating@gmail.com). Artistic entries must include the time that each element begins on the submitted planned program sheet.**

**There will be a \$25.00 fee assessed for failure to submit a Planned Program Sheet by the registration deadline. Skaters will not be permitted to register at the competition until this fee has been paid and a planned program sheet has been completed.** All funds from late Planned Program sheets will be paid to the Skate Canada - Vancouver Island Region.

A tentative schedule of events will be e-mailed to each club with confirmation of entry and also posted on the [Vancouver Island Interclub](#) competition page of the Skating in BC website. Any last minute changes to schedules will be posted on the website and also at the arena. **Please note that events may start up to one half hour earlier than scheduled.**

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- **BC/YK SAFESPORT POLICY:** Phone, video and/or mobile devices must be turned off and put away in bag while in dressing room.
- Skaters may enter only one event per discipline of singles and artistic. Pre-Juvenile and Juvenile competitors may enter STAR 7 or 9 short program in addition to the competitive free program. Depending on scheduling skaters entering STAR 7 or 9 should be prepared to skate two programs on the same day. Skaters choosing to enter multiple events do so with the understanding that there may be scheduling conflicts that are unable to be resolved.
- Should entries in an event be exceeding large, the event will be divided into smaller groups which will be determined by random draw. STAR 1 -3 groups will be divided according to age. Artistic events will be divided by free skate test level first and then if further groups are required, by age.
- **SINGLE ENTRIES:** If an event has only one competitor, the skater will be informed and have the option of skating up an event, skating for an evaluation only, or withdrawing with a refund less handling fee. When skating for an evaluation, feedback may be in the form of judges' comments only, if a technical panel is not available to assess technical content. Skating for an evaluation is only applicable to Podium Pathway categories and STARSkate free skating categories. Competitors may skate up one category higher than they are qualified.
- **MARKING:** Please see the STARskate Competition Program Requirements on the Section website for the marking criteria for each of the STARskate and Supplementary Event categories. Note that the lower levels are all assessed with ribbons awarded. Podium Pathway categories are all marked in CPC, Special O categories will be assessed and ranked with the exception of Level 6 & Open Singles, which will be marked using the CPC scoring system.
- **REGISTRATION:** Skaters must register/check-in at least one hour before they are scheduled to skate.
- **SIZE OF WARM-UP GROUPS:** The maximum number of skaters on warm-up for all STARSkate categories except STAR 1, will be 8.
- **WARM UP TIMES:**

STAR 2	3 minutes
STAR 3, 4 & 5	4 minutes

Pre-Juvenile, STAR 6 to Gold Free Skate	5 minutes
Juvenile to Senior Competitive	6 minutes
Artistic & Showcase	3 minutes
Elements	4 minutes
Special Olympics	6 minutes

At the discretion of the Referee, the warmup periods may be reduced to a minimum of 3 minutes. All warmup periods for one event must be equal.

- **ERNEST FISHER PLAQUE:** There will be a team award for the Vancouver Island Region club accumulating the most points.

Point scoring:      First place – 3              Second place – 2              Third place - 1  
 In events where there are three or less competitors, points will be awarded as follows:  
    First place – 2              Second place – 1              Third place – 0

- **COACHES:** To be at ice level during the events, it is mandatory for all participating coaches to register at the competition and have proof of coach registration & accreditation. Temporary accreditation will be issued by showing current Skate Canada membership and First Aid information for \$25.00 per day (payable to the VI Region Coaches Committee).

- The host club will rope off an area at ice level for the accredited coaches.

- **MUSIC REQUIREMENTS:**

- All skaters with the exception of STAR 1 must submit music online as part of the registration process. **This includes ALL pattern dance music (if applicable).**
- Music will only be accepted electronically via MP3 format. \* \* **Do not begin the registration process until you have your music file ready to load.** Questions can be directed to Sue Smith at [registrarvicompetitions@gmail.com](mailto:registrarvicompetitions@gmail.com)
- Music files are not kept for the next competition. Skaters must submit their music for each individual competition.
- Solo dance competitors who choose to use Skate Canada Contemporary music selections must also submit the music electronically (if applicable).
- Competitors must have their back up files – either USB drive or CD – at the boards when they are competing. The Organizing Competition will accept no responsibility against damage but will take every precaution to safeguard each USB/CD.
- Alternate electronic items such as iPhones, tablets, mp3 players etc. will not be accepted for playing music.
- The preferred backup format is a USB flash drive. If submitting a backup CD, the following requirements must be met:
  - Only one program shall be recorded on each CD.
  - The start of the music shall be recorded on the CD with less than two seconds of lead in.
  - Competitor’s name followed by music time (not skating time) shall be clearly printed on one side of the CD.
  - Each CD shall be enclosed in its plastic container, also marked with the skater’s name, home club, event (indicating short or freeski if applicable) and total music time.

- Admission will be free to all.
- **AWARDS:** Presentation of awards will be in the lobby of the arena. All STAR 1, 2 and 3 skaters, and Elements (Star 2 & 3) will receive ribbons and report cards corresponding to their final assessment. Medals for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place will be awarded in all other events.
- Persons wishing to take photographs of on ice performances are reminded that use of flash cameras is forbidden. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not hamper the skaters or the officials. PLEASE NOTE: you may only take pictures or videos of your own skater.
- **PROTESTS:** [Skate Canada Protest Rule](#) will be followed. In addition, if there is an event using manual calculation where the results are not posted within one hour of the completion of the last event of the day, the protest must be made to the Event Referee within the first hour of the following day's competition. If the Event Referee is unavailable, the protest may be made to the Technical Representative.
- Parents are not allowed in restricted areas and dressing rooms. The host club committee will provide a 'common area' where parents can be with their skaters before they compete.

**\*\*\* ONLINE REGISTRATION\*\*\***

**Vancouver Island Region online registration system is with the company Wufoo.com.** All registrations must be completed using this online system including music submission and planned program information. Please do not begin the registration process until you have your music file and planned program ready for submission.

**The registration system will generate an automatic email to the skater. Coaches do not receive an email confirmation.**

There is no login required to fill out the Wufoo Competition form. Skaters enter their information, including music files, in all the required fields and then click "Submit". A new page then opens in PayPal. All competition entry fees will be processed through PayPal (it is not necessary to have a PayPal account to complete the registration process).

If skaters are unsure of what to enter in the various entry form fields, please contact your coach.

PLANNED PROGRAM SHEETS for all free skate events (including Special Olympic events) except STAR 1, 2, 3 & 4, and Elements must be completed filed online during the registration process by October 14, 2022 (closing date of entries). **The planned program registration system will generate an automatic email to the skater. Coaches do not receive an email confirmation.** Please see your coach for further details. Program updates after Friday, October 14, 2022, need to be submitted no later than Tuesday, November 15, 2022, by emailing to [viregionskating@gmail.com](mailto:viregionskating@gmail.com). **Artistic entries must include the time that each element begins on the submitted planned program sheet.**

There will be a \$25.00 fee assessed for failure to submit a Planned Program Sheet by the registration deadline.
