

# CODES FOR ARTISTIC ELEMENTS

*Updated December 16, 2021*

When competing the planned program content for Artistic events, skaters should also indicate transitions that could be possibly be misidentified as the actual element to be called.

For example, if the skater opens with transitional steps that might look like a step sequence, it is important to identify it so that the intended step sequence is the one that gets entered for the judges to assess. It is also extremely helpful if the skater indicates the time in the program when the required element begins.

The list below has been updated to include abbreviations for types of transitions that should be included in the planned program.
