2019 BC Athlete Trust Bursary Application

CRITERIA

The BC Athlete Trust Bursary shall be awarded to one or more athletes who meet or surpass the following criteria:

- a) Have qualified for the Skate Canada Challenge, Skate Canada Junior National Championships or Skate Canada National Championships in the disciplines of singles, pairs or ice dance as a member of the BC/YK Team.
- b) Attended a post-secondary institution for the 2018/2019 school year OR will graduate from high school in 2019 and plan to attend a post-secondary institution for the 2019/2020 school year. Note that in the case of 2019 high school graduates, bursaries will not be awarded until the applicant has registered for post-secondary courses and submitted proof of registration for 2019/2020 school year.
- c) Have passed all courses in the previous academic year AND are in 'Good Academic Standing' at their post secondary institution and/or high school.

Please note that the number and value of Bursaries awarded is limited by the funds available in any given year.

- This application consists of three parts, all of which must be completed in full and RECEIVED no later than **MARCH 28, 2019**.
- *Applications must be submitted by regular mail. Faxed or emailed applications will not be accepted.*

- Only information provided in/with your application will be considered when awarding bursaries. To that end, please ensure your application is complete and that appropriate time and effort has been taken in completing the questions thoroughly and thoughtfully.
