

## STAR 1-10 Program Information

---

The Skate Canada STAR Program consists of all Skate Canada STAR assessments, as well as STAR competition categories and supplementary Events. For detailed information regarding categories, qualifications and program requirements, refer to the STAR Technical Requirements Guide for the current season.

### **STAR 1-5**

STAR 1-5 assessments are coach-assessed and include skills, free skate and dance. Assessments at the STAR 1-5 level are designed to support skater development within their own environment and remove barriers such as extra costs, inconvenience and time constraints.

### **STAR 6-Gold**

Freeskate or Dance tests scheduled before November 1st will be evaluated in accordance with the existing Sr. Bronze to Gold system.

STAR 6-Gold assessments are offered in an "external evaluation" environment and will be assessed by a qualified evaluator, with the exception of Skills that may be assessed by either an evaluator or the skater's qualified coach assessor.

All coaches are encouraged to complete the new STAR 6-Gold training for each discipline, as it becomes available on Skate Canada's e-learning site.
