



BC/YK Section Kelowna Camp Invitation Process

Many skaters have fond memories of their time at the Kelowna Camp and this special event will continue. Skaters at the STAR 4 and higher levels will now need to meet a minimum qualifying score in order to attend the Kelowna Camp. These scores, which are listed below, are very attainable and are designed to encourage skaters to strive for excellence and improve their skills over a season. Skaters that meet or exceed the eligible score will receive an invitation from the BC/YK Section office to attend the camp. The first invitations will be sent to skaters after December 15th, 2019. As in the past, attendees will be required to pay a fee to attend the camp. The Kelowna Camp will take place April 10-12, 2020.

We will be monitoring results from all Regional and Sectional competitions up until March 8th, 2020 at the Super Series Final competition in Kelowna, BC. Skaters that attain the set target scores will receive an invitation to attend the camp from the BC/YK Section office no later than March 15th, 2020.

The BC/YK Section reserves the right to adjust the target scores based on camp enrollment. Registration in the Kelowna Camp is based on first come first serve. We encourage skaters to respond to invitation letters as soon as possible to ensure a spot at the camp.

Target Scores

Pre Juvenile	19 points
Juvenile	22 points
Pre Novice	62 points (combined Short and Long Program)
Novice	72 points (combined Short and Long Program)
Junior/Senior	82 points (combined Short and Long Program)

Star 4	All Star 4 skaters are invited to apply to attend the camp. Skaters will be selected based on attaining target score before March 5, 2019.
STAR 5	15 points
STAR 6	19 points
STAR 8	21 points
STAR 10	23 points
Gold	25 points
