

WHO MUST BE REGISTERED?



Everyone! Skate Canada Clubs must register everyone participating in any Club program unless another Skate Canada Club has registered them. This includes:

- ✓ Club Board Members
- ✓ All Skaters - including CanSkaters, CanPowerSkate, STARSkaters, and competitive and synchronize skaters.
- ✓ Adult skaters - it is important to select the appropriate activity for your adult skaters.
- ✓ Program Assistants helping with CanSkate or other programs
- ✓ Officials - any Data Specialists, Referees, Judges, Evaluators, Music Players, or Announcers associated with the Club.
- ✓ Members that are a Skate Canada Professional Coach and also a competitive skater are required to register in two categories. These members are required to register with Skate Canada as a Professional Coach and they should also be registered as a competitive skater with their Home Club.

Participants on Club ice who are not registered with Skate Canada are not covered with insurance and your Club board members could be held personally liable should this participant be injured.

When registering members, please ensure accuracy in the name spelling and use upper and lower case for first and last names. Confirm that this is the name of the skater and not a parent. The way that it is entered is how it will be displayed in communications from Skate Canada, including competition skater lists.
