



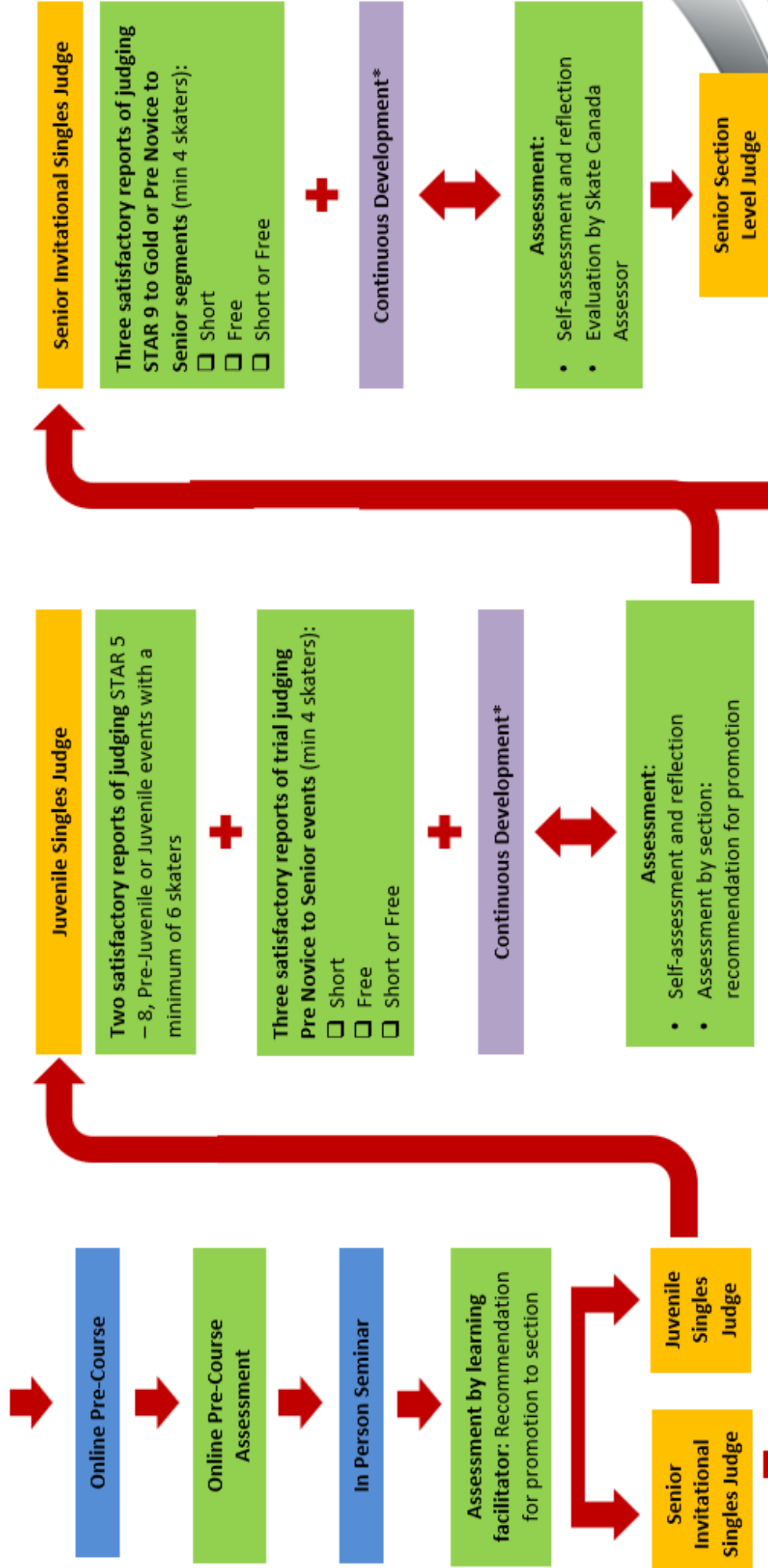
NEW SENIOR SECTION LEVEL JUDGE: SINGLES TRAINING PATHWAY

Training Prerequisite:

- Skating Background:
 - Any two of Junior Bronze/STAR 5 Free Skating, Skills, Dance; or
 - Any one Senior Bronze/STAR 6 Free Skating, Skills, Dance or a Juvenile Competitive test; or
 - Any one higher level test
- STAR 1-4 judge qualification or Juvenile judge qualification (prior to September 1, 2017)

**Examples of Continuous Development (to be recommended depending on candidate)*

- Trial judging (live/video)
- Skate Canada eLearning
- Peer Study
- Mentor
- Seminars
- Learning Bursts



Juvenile Singles Judge

Two satisfactory reports of judging STAR 5 – 8, Pre-Juvenile or Juvenile events with a minimum of 6 skaters



Three satisfactory reports of trial judging Pre Novice to Senior events (min 4 skaters):

- Short
- Free
- Short or Free



Continuous Development*



Assessment:

- Self-assessment and reflection
- Assessment by section: recommendation for promotion

Senior Invitational Singles Judge

Three satisfactory reports of judging STAR 9 to Gold or Pre Novice to Senior segments (min 4 skaters):

- Short
- Free
- Short or Free



Continuous Development*



Assessment:

- Self-assessment and reflection
- Evaluation by Skate Canada Assessor



Senior Section Level Judge
